New Educational Resource to Empower UK Pupils in Advocating for Afghan Girls' Education

In Afghanistan, 1.4 million girls (source UNESCO) have been denied their right to education, significantly impacting their future and the development of their communities.

Resources

<u>This education pack</u> contains information and activities to introduce global issues into the classroom and help teachers and students learn about the lives and thoughts of girls living in Afghanistan, who have been deprived of their right to education.

The resources are designed in three sections.

- Your students can learn about the United Nations Rights of the Child and Global Goals.
- They can read letters from Afghan girls and see examples of their astonishing artwork depicting their lives and fight for education and rights.
- They can also find out about how young people can take action within their school community and beyond to raise awareness of what is happening to Afghan girls and become advocates for education equality.
