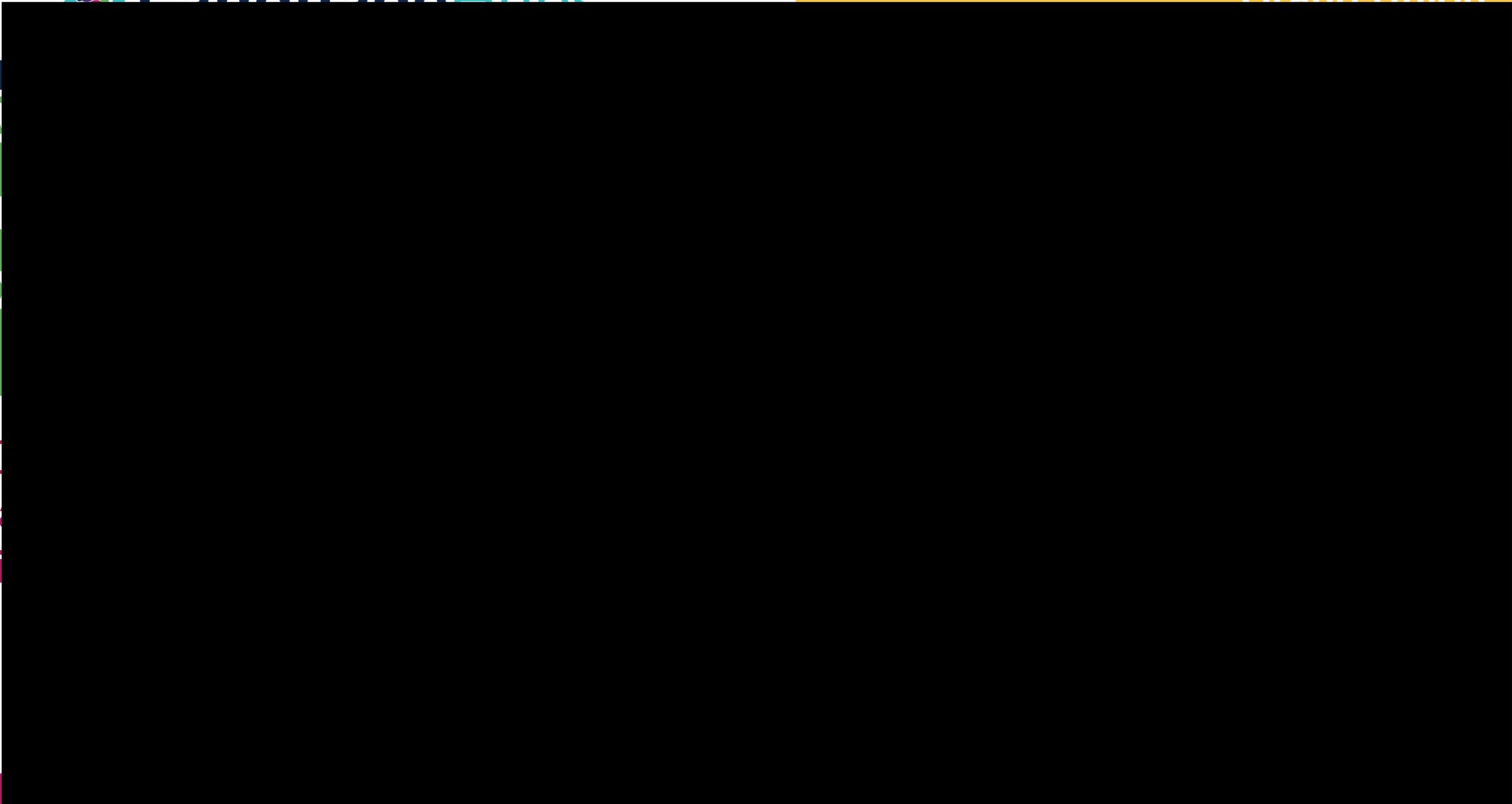

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AI as an analytical tool

Best bets

Ensure you log in to Microsoft Copilot to ensure you have access to all functionalities.

The professional collaborating with AI:
sense check for errors or hallucinations.

Consider the size or format or content of the document that you upload.

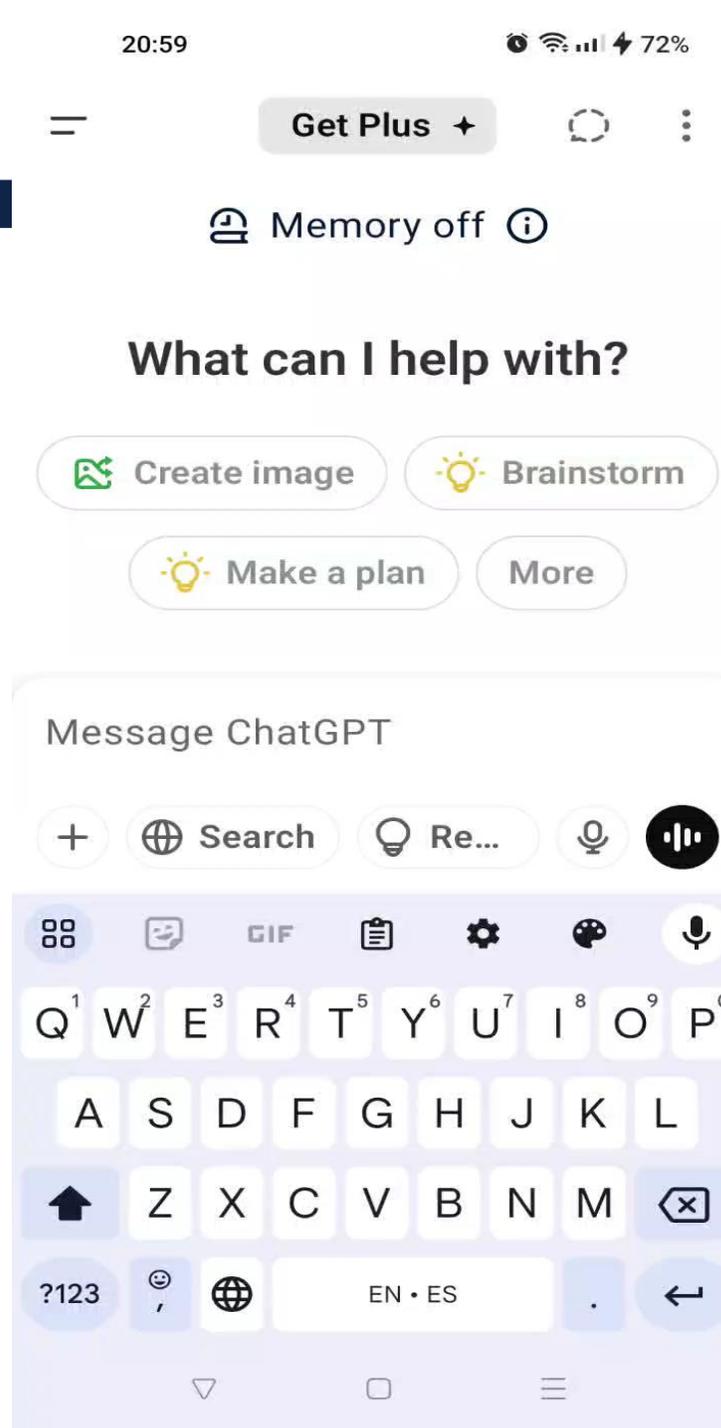
Restrictions: Copilot allows you to only upload one document at a time.

You need to be specific with language prompts and formatting prompts.

It can learn from your previous questions and inputs.

Pitfalls

Pitfalls: AI can make mistakes and miss errors!
